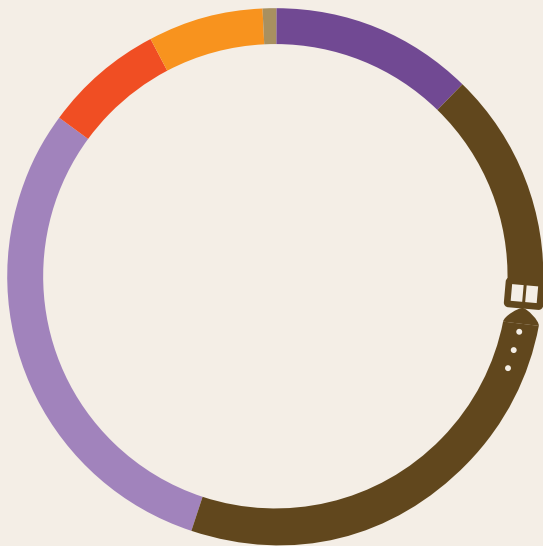

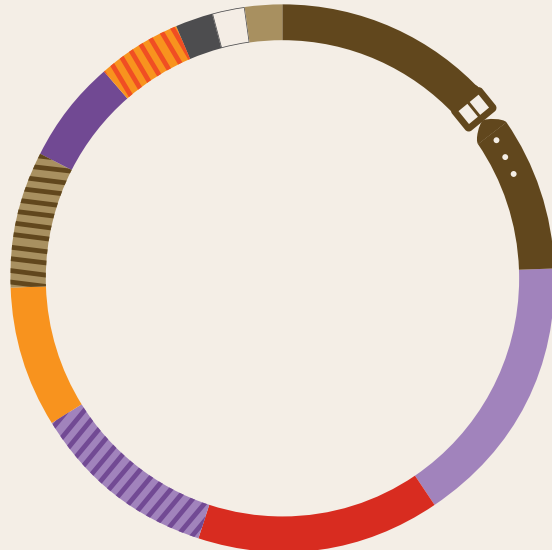

The WHS helps over 10,000 animals a year, both in the shelter and the community. While over a third of these animals are adopted into new forever homes, we also provide behaviour support through classes and the help line, plus community support programs like our Emergency Food Bank, Care to Adopt, the Urgent and Primary Care Programs and the Spay Neuter Assistance Program (SNAP).

April 1, 2021 - March 31, 2022



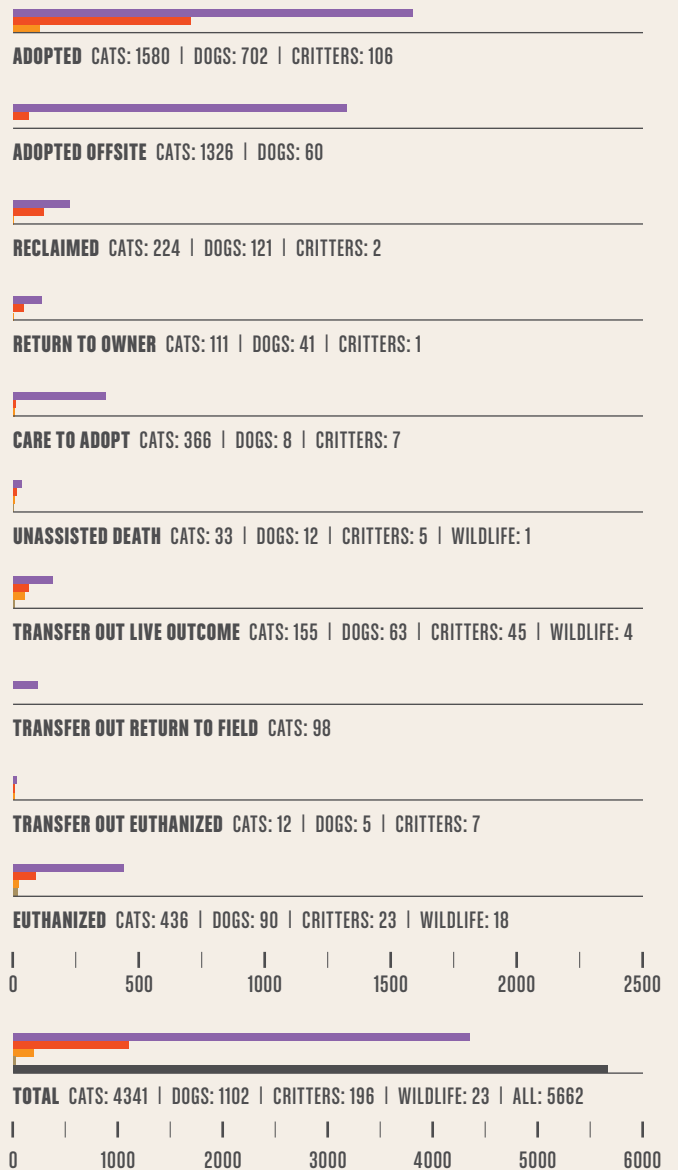
Incoming
