## Here are some of the ways you make a difference every day.

The first stop each animal makes when they arrive at the WHS is the clinic. Our talented veterinary team assesses the animal's physical well-being and determines how to keep them healthy and happy. The clinic is the most expensive area of our shelter to operate and for good reason. It is a fully functioning animal hospital capable of handling everything from standard vaccinations and spay and neuter surgeries to more intensive procedures like dental extractions and orthopedic care.
